


New Westminster College

VISION STATEMENT



MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL ACCREDITATION

New Westminster College believes that its degree, diploma and certificate programs should be accredited by multiple governments and accreditation agencies to ensure official recognition and the highest possible qualitative standards for our education programs. Multi-jurisdictional accreditation will also ensure that our graduates will be much more competitive in the global marketplace because their earned academic credentials will be recognized as being accredited and accepted in more than just one country.



ACCREDITATION IN CANADA

New Westminster College will initiate its accreditation plan in 2015 in Prince Edward Island with the Department of Education, and in 2016 in Quebec with the Ministre de l'Enseignement supérieur, de la Recherche et de la Science. Accreditation must be granted before degrees are awarded.



ACCREDITATION IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

New Westminster College will initiate its accreditation plan in 2016 with the California Postsecondary Education Commission, and subsequently in 2016 with the Accrediting Commission for Schools of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges.



ACCREDITATION IN THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO

New Westminster College will initiate its accreditation plan in 2016 with the Ministry of Higher Education of the Kingdom of Morocco and afterwards with the European Union, and select GCC countries.



VIRTUAL AND PHYSICAL CAMPUSES

New Westminster College will have multiple types of campuses in multiple global locations to grow and serve a global population of 50,000 students. In 2016, an interactive and innovative learning platform will be established as our virtual campus to serve global students and other students from rural communities where attendance at a physical campus is unaccessible. During the period from 2015 to 2024, New Westminster College will establish multiple campus and satellite locations in Canada, the United States of America, the Kingdom of Morocco and other countries.



STUDENT RECRUITMENT

New Westminster College will recruit and grow a global population of 50,000 students from 2015 to 2024. Several large firms from Saudi Arabia, India and China have already been in negotiations with New Westminster College to refer government-screened, approved and funded students to attend our education programs. This will accelerate the growth of our global student body, which will compliment our recruitment of local and regional students. This recruitment strategy will generate revenues in excess of \$750-million dollars.



FACULTY RECRUITMENT

New Westminster College has already been approached by more than 1,000 professors holding doctorates that wish to teach and conduct research with us. A short-list of more than 300 qualified professors have filed their curriculum vitae and are available for full-time or adjunct faculty appointments.



\$4-TRILLION GLOBAL EDUCATION MARKET

The global market for education is valued at \$4.4 trillion, and poised to grow significantly over the next five years, according to an analysis by an international investment bank that advises companies on educational technology.



23% PROJECTED GROWTH IN eLEARNING

According to IBIS Capital, a London-based investment bank, the e-learning market is projected to grow by 23 percent between now and 2017, making it the fastest-growing market in education. The market for e-learning outside of the United States is estimated at serving 1.4 billion students and 62.5 million educators globally.
